On March 1, 2017 we were notified that we were awarded a \$50,000.00 grant from the Meyer Memorial Trust Foundation!! The Meyer Memorial Trust Foundation is a private foundation that is not connected to Fred Meyer, Inc.. Meyer Memorial Trust believes that decent, safe and affordable housing is the foundation for personal stability, thriving families and strong communities, and has dedicated \$15 million from 2015 to 2019 to expand resources to meet the housing needs of Oregonians.

This grant project will focus on addressing immediate health and safety and accessibility issues for elderly or disabled residents who own and live in manufactured homes in parks that were built before 1977. We hope to be able to assist at least 12 families with these funds.
