

**STATEMENT OF WORK**  
**Remove and Replace Fencing**

ADDENDUM NUMBER ONE  
December 13, 2011

The following additions to, deletions from, and clarifications of the Statement of Work (SOW) Documents govern insofar as they apply and shall take precedence over those portions of the original SOW Documents to which they refer. Where any part of the SOW is changed or voided by the following addendum items, the unaltered provisions shall remain in effect. Acknowledge receipt of all addenda on the Bid Form.

**GENERAL:**

Item No. 1 The following are answers to questions raised.

- A. The new fencing will all be 6' feet high except as noted paragraph "B" below.
- B. The Charles Street duplex in Newberg has a retaining wall on the west, north and east sides (See Attachment 1). The retaining wall and fencing are well within the property boundaries. The neighbor's chain link fence on the East side is right on the property line. I will be negotiating with them to see if we can tie into their existing fence, and we will match the height of that fencing around the property to the west side of the property to where it will revert to a 6' fence for the last section. Bid to include new fencing on the east side, but include a deductive alternate if the neighbor's fence is tied into.
- C. The west fencing of the south duplex on Columbia street in Newberg drifts over into the west neighbor's property (See Attachment 2). Correct the fence line to be perpendicular to both the north and the south fences.
