Look out for Red Flags when applying for jobs

Job Search ideas:

- Create a Linkedin profile, start searching in your network.
- Start with the network of people you know, This will be the best way to start your job search.
- Indeed is great for job search. Do not just submit resumes without doing your research!
- Sign up for WorkSource Employment Dept.

Red Flags while looking for a job online:

- They want to pay you through a weird system.
- You can't find much about the company online.
- They're asking for a lot of personal information up front.
- You just don't feel right about it.
- You can't find any information about the company.



- For initial contact, they use their personal email.
- Incomplete job description.
- Vague language.
- Negative reviews from more than just Glassdoor.
- Business name is not always clear or website.
- They ask you for payment to apply.
- If it seems too good to be true, trust your instinct.

How to stand out from the crowd

Always highlight your strengths on your resume and during your interview.

Go old school and send a Thank You card or email thanking them for their time at your interview.
